JACOB); (a) and (b) The Indian Armed Forces have been deployed all along the line of Control in Jammu and Kashmir to prevent infiltration or exfiltration by anti-national elements, and the BSF also works under their operational control there.

Negotiations with ultras in J and K

Influx of Refugees in Tripura

4487. SHRIMATI VEENA VERMA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state;

(a) whether there has been a fresh massive influx of Chakma and other refugees from Bangladesh into Tripura;

(b) if so, the number of refugees who have crossed over into Tripura since April, 1992; and

(c) the steps taken by Government to resettle them and to secure their return to Bangladesh?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI M. M. JACOB); (a) and (b) According to the Government of Tripura about 3000 refugees from Bangladesh entered the State of Tripura recently.

(c) The Prime Minister of Bangladesh visited India in May, 92. In a joint communique after formal talks the two Prime Ministers (India & Bangladesh) agreed to arrange speedy repatriation of all Chakma refugees to Bangladesh in full safety and security. In this context, the Bangladesh side agreed to set up a representative political-level committee that would encourage the refugees to return. The Indian side assured that its authorities would cooperate fully with the process of repatriation.
