Widening of National Highways in Bihar

4555. SHRI S. S. AHLUWALIA: Will the Minister of SURFACE TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have prepared any plan for the widening of inter-State roads and National Highways in Bihar;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) whether Government have earmarked any funds for this purpose;

(d) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(e) the funds released so far and what is the progress made by the State in widening and repairs of roads?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SURFACE TRANSPORT (SHRI JAGDISH TYTLER):

(a) and (b) The programme for development of National Highways including those in Bihar during 8th Five Year Plan and inter-State roads under the Centrally sponsored Scheme is yet to be finalised in consultation with the Planning Commission.

(c) to (e) An amount of Rs. 12.50 crores has been allocated for development of National Highways in Bihar during the current financial year. This includes a sum of Rs. 80.91 lakhs for major on-going works in various stages of progress and new works for widening of National Highways. There is no on-going work of Inter-State Roads in Bihar under Centrally Sponsored Scheme. As regards repairs, out of a total sum of Rs. 866.98 lakhs allocated for maintenance of National Highways in Bihar during 1992-93 a sum of Rs. 479498 lakhs has been released so far. Maintenance and repairs is a continuing activity.
