- (c) Yes, Sir.
- (d) Information is being collected.
- (e) The offer consisted of the supply of General Dynamics' latest complete cryogenic engine and stage Centaur, for use in GSLV, without any technology transfer. Since the offer did not involve technology trans-,, fer and fell short of ISRO's requirements, negotiations with General Dynamics were terminated in March, 1990.

Indians in Afghanistan

4690. SHRI VIRENDRA KATARIA: DR. ABRAR AHMED:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) what is the estimated number of people of Indian origin settled in Afghanistan;
- (b) what is the number of families that have migrated from Afghanistan in the wake of changing political situation in the country;
- (c) whether the refugees from Afghanistan are being settled and what is the nature of assistance being provided by the Government for their resettlement in the country; and
- (d) what steps have been taken by the Government for the safety of lives and property of the people of Indian origin still in Afghanistan?

THE MINISTER OF STATE 'IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AF. i FAIRS (SHRI R. L. BHATIA): (a) and (b) Out of around forty thousand Afghan nationals of Indians origin settled in various parts of Afghani stan, twenty thousand persons are estimated to have left Afghanistan due to unsettled conditions.

(c) Government are in touch with some representatives of these Afghan nationals and will render all assistance considered necessary when required.

(d) Protection of the lives and pro. perty of Afghan nationals of Indian origin is the responsibility of the Government of Afghanistan with whom the matter has been discussed on several occasions.
