**Unearthing of Micro-Organism by NCL for producing quality Paper**

4842. SHRI N. GIRI PRASAD: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that scientists of the National Chemical Laboratory (NCL) have unearthed from the desert sands of Rajasthan a Micro-organism that secretes an enzyme that could help produce high quality paper; and

(b) if so, whether it is also a fact that NCL has launched a joint programme with Iowa State University in the United States and leading U. S. manufacturer for commercialisation of the enzyme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND DEPARTMENT OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. R. KUMARAMANGALAM): (a) Yes, Sir. The National Chemical Laboratory (NCL), Pune has developed a process for the preparation of low molecular weight xylanase from actinomycete strain *chainia*, obtained from the desert sands of Haldighat in Rajasthan.

(b) Yes, Sir. However, since the enzyme is expensive, the results are not very encouraging from technological commercial angle.

The laboratory has alternatively developed another process for cellulase free xylanase which is technologically feasible.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND DEPARTMENT OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. R. KUMARAMANGALAM): The Consultancy Development Centre (CDC) is a Society registered in 1986 under the Society's Act with the main objective to promote the growth and strengthen Consultancy in the country;

(b) Since its inception in 1986, it has been provided a total of about Rs. 2 Crores covering Capital, recurring and programme support. The Annual allocation for the revenue expenditure of CDC for last 3 years is Rs. 11.22 lakhs during 1989-90; Rs. 13.00 lakhs during 1990-91; Rs. 15.00 lakhs during 1991-92.

The returns on the training programmes organised by the Centre were recently analysed and found to be very satisfactory. Internal Rate of Return being over 25 per cent.
