

कोल इंडिया लिमिटेड की कोयला धोवनशालाओं की क्षमता

4653. श्री छोटभाई पटेल : क्या कोयला मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) कोल इंडिया लि० की कोयला धोवनशालाओं की कुल कितनी क्षमता है ;

(ख) क्या सरकार का कोल इंडिया लि० की सभी कोयला धोवनशालाओं का आधुनिकीकरण करने का विचार है ; यदि हां, तो उसका ब्यौरा क्या है ;

(ग) क्या सरकार कोल इंडिया लि० के अधीन दो नई धोवनशालाएं स्थापित करने का विचार रखती है ; और

(घ) यदि हां, तो उसका ब्यौरा क्या है ?

कोयला मंत्रालय में उप मंत्री (श्री एस० बी० नयमगोडा) : (क) कोल इंडिया लि० की वर्तमान कोकिंग कोयला वाशरियों की कच्चे कोयले की उत्पादन क्षमता 25.22 मिलियन टन प्रतिवर्ष है ।

(ख) भारत कोकिंग कोल लि० की दुग्दा I, दुग्दा II, भोजूडीह, पाथरडीह, सुदामाडीह तथा मूनीडीह और सेंट्रल कोल फोल्ड्स लि० की कारगली, कथारा, गिडुडी, राजपुरा और स्वांग की वर्तमान वाशरियों के आधुनिकीकरण का कार्य एक विशेषज्ञ समिति की सिफारिशों पर किया जा रहा है । डेशलिंग संयंत्र की स्थापना तथा फाइन कोयले के परिष्करण करने की व्यवस्था, कच्चे कोयले का फाइनर क्रैशिंग की व्यवस्था और उपकरण/स्वचालन की पद्धति की शुरुआत करना जैसी कुछ मुख्य मद्दे हैं, जिनमें सुधार किया जा रहा है ।

(ग) और (घ) वर्तमान में कोल इंडिया लि० के अंतर्गत स्थापित की जा रही वाशरियों का ब्यौरा नीचे दिया गया है :—

#### Delivery of Sonar simulators to the Indian Navy

(a) whether it is a fact that the Department of Electronics has not delivered sonar simulators to the Indian Navy;

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(b) whether the project has since been closed;

(c) if so, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether the department is now working on some other project; and

(e) if so, the details thereof, stating the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND DEPARTMENT OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. R. KUMARA MANGALAM): (a) to (c) At the specific request of the Indian Navy, the Department of Electronics developed prototype Sonar Simulators. However, for field trial, some specific technical information and assistance were needed from Navy which were not available. Further, as the sonars for which the simulators were required were getting obsolete and being replaced by other sonars, Naval Headquarters suggested to short close the project.

(d) The Department is not working on any project of Sonar Simulator at present.

(e) Does not arise.

proposal under consideration of the Government.

#### **Negotiation with Myanmar for Chakma Refugees**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI R. L. BHATIA): (a) No, Sir.

(b) The Chakma refugees came from Bangladesh. Discussions have been underway with the Government of Bangladesh for their early repatriation.

(c) Government takes all necessary measures to prevent infiltrations across our international borders.
