#### Navodaya Vidyalayas in M.P.

\*244. SHRI SURSH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of districts in Madhya Pradesh where Navodaya Vidyalayas have been opened and those which have been left out;

(b) the reasons for not opening Navodaya Vidyalayas in the remaining districts of the State; and

(c) by when Government propose to open Navodaya Vidyalayas in all the Districts of Madhya Pradesh?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) A statement of 30 Navodaya Vidyalayas functioning in the State of Madhya Pradesh is laid on the table of the House. (See below). In addition to these 9 more Navodaya Vidyalayas have been sanctioned during 1992-93. Thus 6 districts remain.

(b) and (c) Navodaya Vidyalayas are being set up in a phased manner. The Government aims, at present, to set up one Navodaya Vidyalaya, on an average, in each district of the country if possible during the next three years, subject to availability of resources and receipt of suitable proposals from the State Govt.
