At present, there are 3 National Re-
search Professors as indicated below:

(1) Dr. C. R. Rao—Mathematics/
Statistics

(2) Smt. M. Subhulakshmi—Music

(3) Dr. K. N. Raj—Economics

(b) and (c) National Research Pro-
fessorship is an honour which is con-
ferred upon distinguished academics
and scholars in recognition of their va-
luable contribution to knowledge. Per-
sons of real eminence who have at-

tained the age of 65 years and have
made outstanding contribution in their
respective fields and are still capable
of further research are appointed as
National Research Professors. No
specific duties and responsibilities have
been assigned to National Research
Professors. They are free to pur-
sue research work in their chosen fields at
the University or Institution of their
choice. The scheme does not envisage
any evaluation of the work done by
distinguished scholars appointed as Na-
tional Research Professors.
