Areas covered by Integrated Rural Energy Planning

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF NON-CONVENTIONAL ENERGY SOURCES (SHRI SUKH RAM): The Integrated Rural Energy Planning Programme is being taken up in selected blocks in all States and UTs except Chandigarh. Up to 1991-92, 252 blocks have been covered under this programme. The Statewise break up of the blocks covered under the programme is given in the attached statement. (See below) The Programme involved setting up of project cells in the selected blocks which would prepare and monitor the implementation of the block level IREP Projects. It is proposed to extend the programme at the rate of about 100 blocks a year in the 8th Plan. The details of the programme in the 8th Plan are being worked out.
