environmental audit system to asses and control industrial pollution in the country ;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof ;

(c) by when such system is likely to be introduced ; and

(d) the extent to which it is likely to check industrial pollution in the country ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI KAMAL NATH) : (a) to (c) The Government have introduced a scheme for environmental audit under which :—

Every person carrying on an industry, operation or process requiring consent under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 or the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 or both or authorisation under the Hazardous (Management and Handline) Rules 1989 shall submit an environmental audit report for the financial year ending the 31st March in the form prescribed by the Government to the concerned State Pollution Control Board on or before the 15th day of May every year starting from 1993.

(d) Environmental audit is likely to lead to substantial reduction in generation of waste and conservation of natural resources.
