2109. DR. SHRIKANT RAM-CHANDRA JICHKAR : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) the number of Ayurvedic Medical Colleges in the country in Government and Private sectors as on 1st July, 1992 ;

(b) what is the number of students studying in these colleges as on 1st July, 1992 ; and

(c) what is the ideal number of Ayurvedic doctors required in the country ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI-MATI D. K. THARADEVI SIDDHARTHA) : (a) and (b) As per information supplied by Central Council of Indian Medicine, there

are 44 Ayurvedic colleges in Government and 57 colleges in Private Sector recognised by C.C.I.M. About 4500 students are admitted in these colleges every year.

(c) The requirement of Ayurvedic doctors in the country has not been assessed.
