Distinvesment in public sector undertakings at throw away prices

2329. SHRI PRAMOD MAHAJAN: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whather Government are aware of the fact that disinvestments of Public Sector Undertakings shares have been done at throw away prices in last one year; and
- (b) if so, what are the details thereof and the action taken by Government in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (DEPARTMENT OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI P. K. THUNGON). (a) and (b) The shares of Public Sector Undertakings have not been disinvested at throw away prices. The average realisation from the sale of shares were quite higher than the reference price fixed within the parameters of guidelines issued by the Controller of Capital Issues.

Regulation of consumer goods industries

2330. SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government have decided to regulate the consumer goods industries for balancing foreign exchange inflow on account of dividend payments; and
- (b) If so, the results accrueing from the schrme?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (DEPART-MENT OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOP-MENT) (SHRIMATI KRISHNA SAHI): (a) As per para 39 B (ii) of the Statement on Industrial Policy tabled in both Houses of Parliament in July, 1991, outflows on account of dividend payments are to be balanced by export earnings over a period of time. This condition continues to be applicable to foreign investment approvals for specified industries in the consumer goods sector though it has from all other sectors been withdrawn from 26th June, 1992 as a part of Government's continuing economic liberalisation and to further stimulate foreign investment.
