

THE MINISTER OF STATE
IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI K. C. LENKA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The Government of India have taken up/propose to take up a number of programmes for increasing feed and fodder availability in the country which include the following:

1. Central Sector Programmes:

- (i) Quality fodder seed production and transfer of fodder production technology through the regional stations for forage production and demonstration and Production the Central Fodder Seed

Farm, Hessarghatta; and

- (ii) Fodder Minikit Demonstration Programme.

2. Centrally Sponsored Schemes:

- (i) Strengthening of fodder seed farms in the States;
- (ii) Fodder Seed Production through registered growers;
- (iii) Programme for enrichment of straws and cellulosic wastes;
- (iv) Establishment of silvi pasture system for increasing biomass production; and
- (v) Assistance for grass land development including grass reserves.

National Live Stock Feed Grid

(a) whether Government propose to develop a national live stock feed grid on the lines of the national milk grid;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

Production of Jute and Mesta

(c) what steps Government propose to take in this regard?

(c) Besides market and price support, a centrally sponsored scheme on "Special Jute Development Programme (SJDP)" is being implemented in important Jute/mesta growing States. The scheme provides financial assistance to the States for supply of essential inputs required for increasing productivity. Besides, demonstrations are organised for disseminating advanced technology and farmers are trained for production technology.

Allocation of Wheat and Rice for Gujarat

(a) whether it is a fact that Government of Gujarat has demanded from the Central Government Foodgrains for the year 1992-93 ;

(b) if so, what is the demand of the State Government and whether the Chief Minister of Gujarat has requested for enhancement of allocation of wheat and rice for the State; and

(c) what is the reaction of the Government of India in regard thereto ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL SUPPLIES AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI KAMALUDDIN-AHMED) : (a) to (c) The Chief Minister of Gujarat had written

in April, 1992 to step up the allocation of wheat from the Central Pool to one lakh tonnes per month. Keeping in view the stock position of wheat in the Central Pool and other related factors the allocation of wheat to the State has been increased from 60,000 tonnes in April, 1992 to 65,000 tonnes per month from May, 1992.
