140 other vulnerable / sensitive stations of Indian Railways (under outright purchase model). This system consists of the following four broad areas:-

- 1. Internet protocol based CCTV System.
- 2. Access control.
- 3. Personal and baggage screening system.
- 4. Explosive detection and disposal system.

Guidelines & technical specifications of equipment have been circulated to the General Managers of Indian Railways for implementing the project.
