

Construction of New Integrated Terminal Building at existing Non-metro airports: Aurangabad (99.67), Bhopal (135.04), Bhubaneswar (145.54), Chandigarh (77.97), Gaya (13.26), Indore (135.60), Khajuraho (75.32), Lucknow (129.38), Madurai (128.76), Mangalore (147.01), Pune (96.30), Raipur (135.72), Ranchi (137.79), Trichy (74.7), Udaipur (77.44), Varanasi (94.11) and Vishakhapatnam (94.94). Construction of new integrated terminal building at Coimbatore airport has also been planned subject to acquisition of land. Additionally, there is also plan for construction of new integrated terminal building at Vadodara airport subject to finalization of estimates. Above projects are besides the modernisation work presently underway at the major metro airports viz IGI airport, Delhi (8975), CIS airport, Mumbai (9802), NSCBI airport, Kolkata (1942.51), Chennai airport (1808).

Aviation projects in Uttar Pradesh

711. SHRI MOHAMMED ADEEB: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of ongoing works and projects of his Ministry in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) those which are likely to be completed on time and those running behind schedule;
- (c) whether it is a fact that most of the works are not completed in time; and
- (d) if so, the reasons for the same and the remedial measures taken in the matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL): (a) to (d) Details of ongoing works at the airports in Uttar Pradesh are as under:

Lucknow Airport:

1. 67% works of construction of new apron and taxiway has been completed with expected date of completion by March, 2009. The work has initially been delayed due to slow mobilisation of resources by the Agency for which letter has been issued to the Agency to increase the resources for early completion of the work.
2. 36% works of the construction of Integrated terminal building has been completed. The work has been delayed due to change in layout of building, late receipt of structural drawings and local disturbance by the villagers. The Agency has been asked to expedite the progress of work.
3. Construction of Fire Station and Emergency Medical Centre has just been started. The delay occurred due to land dispute with the villagers. The matter has been taken up with the State Government to resolve the issue.

Furstganj (Rae Bareli):

85% works of construction of hostel building, class room, quarters at Indira Gandhi Rashtrya Uran Academy has been completed with expected date of completion by March, 2009. The delay has occurred due to late receipt of structural drawings and slow mobilization of resources by the Agency. In this regard, letter has been issued to the Agency to increase the resources.

Varanasi airport:

1. 56% works of construction of new terminal building has been completed with expected date of completion by March, 2009. The delay occurred due to change in location and layout of the terminal building, late receipt of structural drawings and rains from June to September, 2008. Layout was revised due to site requirement. Letter has already been issued to the Agency to expedite the progress of work.
2. 25% works of expansion of apron, construction of taxiway, extension of runway and allied works with expected date of completion by June, 2009.

Delayed air operations at Delhi Airport

712. SHRI NANDI YELLAIAH: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether his Ministry is seized of the data collected by Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport's Operation Control Centre (OCC) which reveal that about 110 departures and 140 arrivals are delayed at IGI each day on an average due to operational and technical delays by airlines, such as untimely loading of baggage, delayed repairing and replacement of aircraft parts, cabin crew reporting late, catering trucks and fuel trucks arriving late and step ladders going missing; and

(b) if so, the remedial measures taken to run flights as per schedule at IGI Airport?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL): (a) and (b) Average number of flights delayed due to operational and technical delay by airlines during last one month are about 15-20 departure and 15-20 arrivals per day. Other delays are due to various reasons like late arrival of flights, bad weather etc. However, for efficient and smooth process of airlines, Delhi International Airport Limited has done various improvement on infrastructure facilities at IGI airport like, at airside-commissioning of 3rd runway and associated taxiway, commissioning of additional rapid exit taxiways and fillets for improving the aircraft movement, increased CAT-III bays, introduced Power in Push Back for optimal use of airside bring operation and safety improvement, introduced three tier parking in Satellite Apron to accommodate more parking bays, commissioning of Rubber removal machine for upkeep of the runways. At international terminal, increased check in counters, increased X-ray machines, increased DFMD gates, increased immigration counters, implemented in-line X-ray baggage screening system, 4 single entry gates have been replaced by 4 double entry gates etc. Similarly, improved infrastructure facilities are provided at domestic departure and arrivals terminals and also at city side domestic and city side international.

Upgradation of Bhubneshwar Airport
