Drinking water quality testing laboratories

(a) whether the country occupies the 120th position on the list 122 countries assessed for the quality of drinking water;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the number of Drinking Water Quality Testing Laboratories functioning in the country as on date, State-wise;

(d) whether Government is considering to establish Drinking Water Quality Testing Laboratories in all districts in the Country; and

(e) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI CHANDRA SEKHAR SAHU): (a) and (b) From time to time, different organizations/institutions publish reports/documents on different issues, wherein ranking of various countries are also shown. In a United Nations World Water Development Report — “Water for People Water for Life” published in 2003, a table entitled “water quality indicator values in selected countries” was included wherein India was shown at serial number 120 out of 122 countries.

(c) to (e) To set up district water testing laboratories in all such districts, where such a facility is not available, Government of India has been providing financial assistance to States/UTs and so far, 449 laboratories have been sanctioned. Another 164 water testing

laboratories have been set up by the respective State Governments/UT Administrations and 15 laboratories by others. As per information available, State-wise details of water testing laboratories sanctioned and established is enclosed as a Statement.

(b) Rs. 1165.27 crore has been released to Madhya Pradesh under PMGSY during the year 2006-07, Rs. 1615.66 crore during 2007-08 and Rs. 1848.70 crore so far during 2008-09.
