THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIAPPA): (a) and (b) No, Sir. Presently road improvement schemes proposed by State Governments in Naxal-affected areas are being sanctioned under annual budgetary allocation for National Highways and Central Road Fund for State Roads. State-wise details of the sanction accorded are as under:—

(a) the details of National Highways (NHs) in Uttar Pradesh (UP);

(b) the details of those which are in poor, unsatisfactory, satisfactory, good and excellent condition, respectively;

(c) the amount earmarked and spent on each of them during the last three years, year-wise; and

(d) those NHs in Uttar Pradesh which require further widening and development and the plans therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIAPPA): (a) The total length of National Highways in Uttar Pradesh is 5874 km. and the details thereof are given in the Statement (*See below*).

(b) All stretches of National Highways in Uttar Pradesh are maintained in traffic worthy condition.

(c) The allocations are made State-wise and not NH-wise. During last three years, the allocation and expenditure incurred on the development and maintenance of National Highways in the State of Uttar Pradesh is as under:—
