- (c) At present there is no such proposal under consideration of the Government. However, the beneficiaries of Kalibari dispensary are availing Emergency Service from Gole Market dispensary.
- (d) In view of reply given at (c) above, the question does not arise.
- (c) Due to financial constraints, it is not possible to provide Emergency Services in Kali Bari Dispensary at present.

### Selection of Students for M.S. Studies

- 867. SHRI TINDIVANAM G. VEN-KATRAMAN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) the number of backward and most backward students who passed M.B.B.S. and were selected for M.S. studies by the Central Government during 1992; and
- (b) whether Government propose to fix norms for selecting backward and most backward class M.B.B.S. students for M.S. course?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) The Government do not make any classification of the students passing M.B.B.S. examination in terms of backward or most backward students. The Central Government Medical Institutions are however, required to reserve 15% seats for Scheduled caste and 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribe Candidates.

(b) Does not arise.

### Mouth and Throat Cancer in Bihar

- 868. SHRI S.S. AHLUWALIA; Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that there is an alarming rise in the number of mouth and throat cancer patients in Bihar;
- (b) if so, what are the details thereof with the number of mouth and throat cancer patients detected and undergoing

- treatment upto 31st March, 1992 in the State; and
- (c) what remedial action Government have taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) There is no specific information regarding the number of mouth and throat cancer patients in Bihar. The data collected under the National Cancer Registry Programme of the Indian Council of Medical Research do not indicate any increase in the incidents of Oral cancer over the years.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

#### Autonomous Status to JIPMER

- 869. SHR1 RAMACHANDRAN PILLAT: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government are aware of the appeal of Anti-Conversion Action Committee of JIPMER Hospital, Pondicherry against reported proposal for converting JIPMER into an autonomous organisation; and
- (b) if so, the reasons for such proposal?
- THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) In order to achieve maximum functional efficiency and the over all growth of the Institute.

### Reservation Policy of AlIMS

- 870. SHRI RAMACHANDRAN PIL-LAI: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that since 1975 upto 1990 sixteen posts of senior Residents in the ENT Department of AllMS, New Delhi were filled and only one Scheduled Caste candidate was appointed amongst them in the year 1986;

- (b) whether it is also a fact that all the Faculty posts created and filled up in the Department since its inception have so far been scrupulously kept outside the purview of the reservation orders; and
- (c) if so, what action is proposed to be taken to direct the AHMS to follow the principle laid down in the Supreme Court judgement of 21st August, 1990 by cancelling all the recent advertisements/ appointments made of senior Residents and faculty posts in ENT department?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) No, Sir. AllMS is following the reservation policy as decided by its Institute/Governing Body. The Institute has decided that the reservation would be against the total number of vacancies of Lecturers/Asstt. Professors without reference to speciality/department. This decision while obviating the persistent difficulty filling up the reserved posts of Lecturers/Asstt. Professors in certain disciplines also provided for a better overall representation to the SC/ST. The Supreme Court judgement is not strictly applicable to the appointment/resignation made by AHMS.

#### Cancer Institute in Assam

- 871. SHRI BHADRESHWAR BURA-GOHAIN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that Government have given its clearance for setting up of a Cancer Institute in Assam;
- (b) if so, by when the institute is likely to be set up; and
- (c) if not, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RE-SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHR! ARJUN SINGH): (a) to (c) In Assam there is one Dr. B. Barooah Cancer Institute, Guwahati which has been recognised as a Regional Cancer Centre. During the year 1991-92, Government of India has provided an amount of Rs. 70.00 lakhs for development of Oncology Wing in Silchar Medical College and Hospital, Silchar in Assam.

## Consultancy Services by CMO, Homoeopathy
