(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI AJAY MAKEN): (a) and (b) Based on the requirement projected by the Organizing Committee of the Commonwealth Games 2010, the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has been entrusted with the construction of the Commonwealth Games Village to accommodate 8000 athletes and officials during the Games. As part of this project, DDA is constructing 1168 apartments with 4008 rooms on double occupancy basis. Further, the additional accommodation required during the Games is to be provided through creation of additional hotel rooms, not only in the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi, but also at other locations in the National Capital Region. The Bed and Breakfast Scheme launched by the Government of NCT of Delhi and liberalization of guest house norms are some additional measures to augment accommodation in the city for the Games.

Financial assistance under UIDSSMT

State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) of Maharashtra has recommended 115 projects on various components under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Town (UIDSSMT), out of which 34 projects at an approved cost of Rs. 77356.76 lakh involving total Central commitment of Rs. 62476.87 lakh have been sanctioned so far.

(c) and (d) Rs. 21949.44 lakh has been released as 1st installment of Additional Central Assistance (ACA) during 2006-07, 2007-08 and during the current financial year *i.e.* 2008-09 and amount of Rs. 9589.30 lakh as ACA has been released to the State as per priority provided by the State.
