- (ix) Providing cranes and ambulances to various State Government/NGOs under National Highway Accident Relief Service Scheme. National Highways Authority of India also provides ambulances at a distance of 50 Km. on each of its completed stretches of National Highways under its Operation and maintenance contracts.
- (x) Widening and improvements of National Highways from 2 lanes to 4 lanes and 4 lanes to 6 lanes etc.

Four-laning of NHS in Kerala

1217. PROF. P.J. KURIEN: Will the Minister of SHIPPING, ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of National Highways in Kerala and the portion which is four-laned;

A total length of 883 km is planned to be four laned, of which 77km is already four laned. This will cover entire length of NH-47 and MH-17 in Kerala. The planned length for four laning is expected to be completed by December, 2013.
