## Damage to crop and soil due to recent flood

†1263. SHRI PRABHAT JHA: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the flood, which ravaged various parts of the country this year, has not only caused heavy damage to Kharif crop, but also decreased the fertility of the soil;
  - (b) if so, whether any assessment has been made by Government in this regard;
  - (c) if so, State-wise details of the damage caused to the crops by the flood;
- (d) whether Government is considering to provide any help to the farmers to compensate the loss; and
  - (e) if so, the steps being taken by Government to improve the fertility of the soil?

## Non-fixation of MSP for agricultural products

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government has still not declared the MSP for 14 agricultural products even after the beginning of Kharif season;
  - (b) if so, the details of agricultural products whose MSP has not been fixed so far;
  - (c) the reasons for the enormous delay in fixing the MSP for the above products; and
  - (d) by when, the MSP for the above 14 products is going to be fixed by Government?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTILAL BHURIA): (a) to (d) The Minimum Support Prices of all Kharif Crops of 2008-09 season, comprising of fourteen crops, have already been fixed by the Government in August, 2008.
