

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The basic objective of the public private partnership initiatives is to strengthen the Railway's infrastructure and improve services to customers. These do not entail any dilution of the public sector character of Railways and compromise of Government's interests.

The guidelines and interministerial appraisal/approval laid down by Government in this regard are fully adhered to.

Agreement between Indian railways and Iran's railway company
