100 days plan to make internal security effective

†1791. SHRI SHREEGOPAL VYAS: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Prime Minister has announced a 100 days plan to make internal security effective;

(b) whether its outline has been drawn; and

(c) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SHRIPRAKASH JAISWAL): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The Prime Minister in the Conference of Directors General of Police/Inspectors General of Police (DGPs/IGPs) and Chiefs of Central Police Organisation (CPO) held on 22-23, November, 2008 announced the establishment of a Task Force which would initiate a 100 day plan to develop an integrated capability to address emerging challenges in areas such as Left Wing Extremism, terrorism and insurgency; improve the ability to anticipate and prevent surprises, through closely networked intelligence collaboration and upgradation of both human and technological intelligence; create an awareness regarding the critical importance of strategic foresight in regard to social and political developments; develop a net-centric information command structure that enables both States and Central agencies to access and exploit information in a secure manner and well in time; strengthen inter-state and inter-agency cooperation; and ensure innovation and technological leadership. The Task Force with suitable representation from the Central and State agencies, is to come out in a period of 100 days with a road map regarding the detailed steps to be taken immediately as also the subsequent steps to be taken over the next several months so as to translate this vision of an integrated net-centric capability into reality. Action in this regard is underway.

National Cyclone Disaster Management Institute

(a) whether there is any proposal to set up National Cyclone Disaster Management Institute in the country;

(b) if so, the details and locations identified to set up such institute and the amount allocated for the same; and
