*278.SHRI BISWAJIT DAIMARY: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether railway lines from Rangia to Murkongsilec (Jonai) and Guwahati to Cacher are being upgraded from metre-gauge to broad-gauge;
 - (b) if so, the schedule of their completion;
 - (c) if not, the reasons for delay;
- (d) whether in Agartala, Railways have taken a metre-gauge line recently instead of a broad-gauge line;
 - (e) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for not providing broad-gauge line instead;
- (f) whether there is any provision to extend railway line to Meghalaya, Mizoram and Manipur which are having tourist potential;
 - (g) if so, the details thereof; and
 - (h) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI LALU PRASAD): (a) Yes, Sir. The work of gauge conversion of Rangiya-Murkongselek and M.G. part of Guwahati-Cacher, *i.e.* Lumding-Silchar-Jiribam & Badarpur-Kumarghat and Katakhal-Bairabhi has been taken up.

- (b) The target for completion of Rangiya-Murkongselek gauge conversion has been fixed as March, 2012 and Lumding-Silchar-Jiribam & Badarpur-Kumarghat and Katakhal-Bairabhi has been fixed as March, 2011.
 - (c) Does not arise.
- (d) and (e) The existing rail network beyond Lumding southwards is on Meter Gauge for which gauge conversion has been taken up. To provide rail connectivity to Agartala, the Meter Gauge service has been extended. However, the line has been constructed to Broad Gauge standards and will be converted once gauge conversion of Lumding-Badarpur-Kumarghat is completed
- (f) to (h): For extending Railway line in Meghalaya, Mizoram and Manipur, following works have been taken up:
