- (c ) the new Jan Shikshan Sansthans set-up during the last two years, those to be set-up during 2001-2002, location-wise, under whose control they are functioning and the number of beneficiaries, and
- (d) when Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan was launched indicating the number of preparatory activities, the districts covered at present and by when all districts would be covered under this and other schemes, for total emancipation of illiterate?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT: (DR. MURLI MANOHAR JOSHI): (a) Since the inception of National Literacy Mission, 9.153 crores persons in 15-35 age group have been made literate under different schemes up to 31.12.2000.
