THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV) : 5.28 lakh MTs. of rice were allocated to Chhattisgarh free of cost for Food for Work Programme (FFWP). An amount of Rs. 58.94 crore was also allocated from the National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF) for drought.

Amendment in the Quarantine Law

†1984. **SHRI RAJNATH SINGH 'SURYA' :** Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn towards the news-item published in the Hindustan dated 26th October, 2001 under the caption, Quarantine Kanoon me Sanshodhan;

(b) if so, whether there is any proposal to amend this law; and

(c) if so, whether any provision for the necessary certification in this regard would be made through the same ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV) : (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The news-item published in the Hindustan dated 26-10-2001 refers to the National Facility for Virus Diagnosis and Quality Control of Tissue-culture raised Planting Material by the Department of Biotechnology. It also mentions National Containment-cum-Quarantine Facility for Transgenic Planting Material set up at National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources, New Delhi. The imported Tissue-culture raised Planting Material is already covered under the Quarantine Law. Import of Transgenic Planting Material except for research purposes is not permitted presently. There is no proposal to amend the Quarantine Law in this regard at present.
