coal, Short-Term Linkage Committees determine the quantity of coal to be supplied quarterly to core-sectors like power and cement based on the recommendations of the competent sponsoring authorities. Coal India Ltd. and Singareni Collieries Company Limited allocate coal to other consumers based on the recommendations of competent sponsoring authorities. Coal India Limited also release coal on free-sale basis to all consumers; including those without sponsorship, from certain specified mines placed under 'Liberalised Sale Scheme', at the rate of not more than 1000 tonnes at a time, on 'first come first serve' basis.

(b) and (c) Coal Distribution Policy requires periodical reviews to adjust to changing patterns of demand and supply in order _ to maximise consumer satisfaction. Such reviews are conducted as and when necessary and it may not be possible to indicate the changes likely to be effected on the basis of such reviews.

Joint production of MIG-29/T-72 MI Tanks with Russia

1228. CHOWDHRY HARI SINGH: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(d) and (e) The country has acquired capability to build submarines with material packages obtained from various sources including ex-import depending on the design of the submarines.
