THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR (SHRI PABAN SING GHATOWAR) - (a) The State-wise estimates of educated unemployed, made on the basis of last survey of National Sample Survey Organisation on employment and unemployment (July, 1987 - June, 1988) (latest available) are given in the statement annexed (See below). Information is not compiled District-wise/Tehsil-wise.

(b) Besides the employment generation taking place in the normal development process, additional employment is also generated through the special employment programmes. Employment is also a central objective of the Eighth Five Year Plan.
