SHRI A. G. KULKARNI

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: But I because of my age and faltering voice, I cannot make myself bold to outwit either my friend / Mr. Pandey or.. (Interruptions) But I think now the days of people like me are over because the Chair is not protecting me.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The time has come when the Chair should be protected (Interruptions). Now, may I ask Mr. Gandhi to speak? (Interruptions). I will call you. (Interruptions).

SHRI A.G. KULKARNI: What is the use of it? You are only looking to the people who are shouting and not to the saner elements. (Interruptions).

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I take a very serious note of it. I am looking at the people who are shouting to ask them to stop shouting. I have to look at them to ask them to keep quiet. (Interruptions).

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: I think, you are unsuccessful.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Now if that is the observation, then I will go ahead with the business—Calling Attention to Matter of Urgent Public Importance. All right, I am only doing my job. (Interruptions). The comment which he made on the Chair is unfortunate. I am going ahead with the busi-

At that time everybody wants to speak. (Interruptions).

SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY
(Uttar Pradesh): Madam, you are doing a first class job. (Interruptions).

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I don't need praise. I know what I am doing.

SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY:

Re PROTECTION OF THE DISPUTED SHRINE IN AYODHYA

SHRI RAJ MOHAN GANDHI
(Uttar Pradesh): Madam Deputy Chairman, you have very kindly called me and through you I beg the calm attention of the House and the Government. At the last meeting of the National Integration Council the Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh gave an assurance to the NIC and to the nation that the disputed structure in Ayodhya would be protected by his Government. This morning in the reported newspaper *The Economic Times* this story has appeared on the front page:

"VHP to hoist flags on shrine with UP govt, assent—The Vishwa Hindu Parishad, in association with its one-time rival in Ayodhya—Shri Ram Janamhioomi Sewa Samiti—is planning to hoist saffron flags atop the domes of the disputed sixteenth century shrine again on January 8, 1992. This time, however, it would be done with the Uttar Pradesh Government's forma! assent."

The 'Economic Times, story refers to a report from Ayodhya" front-paged in the latest issue of the RSS organ, Panchjanya, headlined: "Plans to hoist flags atop domes again and uracads as fol lows,

"The report after announcing the plan, goes into the details of the programmes and cate orically asserts that the UP Government is being consulted at every step and that flags will be hoisted after due clearance from the Kalyan Singh Government."

SHRI RAJ MOHAN GANDHI: Madam Deputy Chairman, I am disappointed that the Home Minister who was here is no longer in his seats but I want, through you and the House, to appeal to the Bhartiya Janata Party— believe in making an appeal—to stick to your word and to realise your responsibility as a party governing Uttar Pradesh and three other important States.

Next, I want, through you, to appeal to the Government: Use your channels to talk with the BJP.

Now Bhausaheb Deoras, of course, wants the BJP and the Congress to come close together. What the Congress will do on that and what the BJP will do on that is the BJP's affair and the Congress's affair, but it is the minimum duty of the Government to use its channels with the BJP to make sure that this decision is reversed.

And finally, Madam Deputy Chairman, through you and this House, I want to appeal to the Hindus of India whose loud speakers, amplifiers and megaphones have been captured by an extie-mist Hindu Group. I want, through this House, to appeal to the Hindus of India that they may not allow the reputation of Hindu society to be damaged in the eyes of the world, in the eyes of posterity and before the conscience of tomorrow's Hindus. Thank, you.

SHRI SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY (Uttar Pradesh): Madam, I have a short point to make. There is a major international event that has taken place and that is independence of Ukraine and it is incumbent on the Government to make a statement as to what the Government's position is. There is an utter confusion as to whether we will go along to recognise Ukraine or not. Therefore, the Government should come forward and make clear its policy on the dissipating Soviet Empire.

Re. NEED TO RAISE THE PRICE OF RUBBER

SHRI N. E. BALARAM (Kerala): Madam, I will take just a few minutes. We, the Members who are coming from Kerala, are facing a difficulty. The rubber-growers in Kerala have decided to go on *dharma* before the houses of all the Members of Parliament from Kerala within a week. They have given us notice. They say they are not getting a proper price. There is a steep fall in the price of rubber. Last year it was Rs. 22 per kilogram. This year it is Rs. 17.08 per kilogram. So, they have decided to stage a big *dharma* before the houses of all Members of Parliament from Kerala. Therefore, I would request, through you, the Government that the Government should take immediate measures so that the rubber-growers would get proper price. They are seven lakhs in number. (Interruptions)

SHRI M. A. BABY (Kerala): Madam, with your permission I would like to raise the issue of the annual conference of the Indian Council of Historical Research that was to be held recently. As we all know this has been one of the most prestigious establishments in our country. It has contributed tremendously to the growth of historical research in the country. But unfortunately for the first time in the history of the Indian Council of Historical Research, the annual conference had to be postponed due to the negative attitude of the State Government of Madhya Pradesh. The Conference was to be held in Bhopal and all necessary arrangements were made. But at the last moment the State Government did not release sufficient funds and it had to be postponed.
