

Stagnation and frustration in I.T.D.C. employees

3346. SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION AND TOURISM be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of employees in I.T.D.C.; designation wise and scale wise as on 31st January, 1992, who are eligible for promotion to the executive cadre;

(b) what is the number of those I.T.D.C. employees who joined in the particular non-executive position on a particular date and subsequently after their due promotions reached to the level of Assistant Manager and above as on date; and

(c) whether it is a fact that due to defective promotion and seniority rules there exist large scale stagnation and frustration in I.T.D.C., if so, the factual position thereof and action being taken to make them more progressive to suit the majority interest of employees and the organisation as well in the near future;
