THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI D.K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) Though once full blown both the diseases, i.e. Rabbies and AIDS, are nearly 100 per cent fatal, the former can be revented even after the exposure if vaccine is administered in time. No such vaccine is available for AIDS which can only be prevented at the pre-infection stage by ensuring safety of blood and behavioural modifications.

- (b) There is no National Rabies Control Programme.
- (c) No such comparison is therefore, possible.

Work ou pesticides by NIN

3545. SHRI B. K. HARI-PRASAD: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WEL-FARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whther it is feet that in 1977 and so NIN, Hyderabad had done some pioneening work on pestilelds, which has caused dwarfism (Hanilgedu Syndreme) in Chik magu)ar and if so, details thereof indicating whether the final report on the droject has been grepared aLd if so, when;
- (b) whether any follow up work has been undertaken on the subject and if so, details thereof;
- (c) whether ICMR had done any similar studies on the epilepsy due to pesticides and frequent deaths due to celphos and if so, details thereof; and
- (d) whether the ICMR propose to set up a full-fledged division at one of its national laboratories to handle this work intensively and effectively in view of dangers, including cancer associated with pesticides?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIMATI D. K. THARA DEVI SIDDHARTHA): (a) and (b) The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) conducted a multi-institumulti-disciplinary tional between 1985 and 1990 in Shimoga District of Karnataka State. This study had identified Handigodu disease as a syndrome of genetically determined multiple epiphyseal dysplasia particularly affecting eipiphyses at hips, wrist, knee and the spine producing vairable clinical and radioligical syndrone of bone disease and deformties. No evidence is available which would indicate that the pesticides are the cause of dwarfism. The final report of the study has not been published so far.

- (c) No such studies have been conducted by the ICMR on epilepsy.
- (d) The ICMR's National Occupational Health Ahmedabad is already having a Division which works on experimental evaluation of pesticides commonly used in India and also initiates epidemiological investigations.

Medical facilities to Uttarkashi victims
