

**Ozone layer in South India**

3514. SHRI JOHN F. FERNANDES : will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that Ozone Layer in South India is depleted due to environmental pollution;

(b) if so, what Corrective environmental steps are being taken; and

(c) what further steps are being taken to educate the people of the area on preventive measures ?
