

### Library Movement

4152. SHRI SHIV PRATAP MISHRA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that government have formulated a comprehensive scheme for a massive library movement; and

(b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) In 1972, the Central Government set up the Raja Rammohun Roy Library Foundation, Calcutta with the primary objective of giving an impetus to the public library movement. The foundation has been striving to take the library movement to small towns and villages and to provide reading facilities for all sections of people, through its various assistance schemes for the States/Union Territories and also for voluntary organisations in the field of libraries. Separately, the National literacy Mission envisages the establishment of Tana Shikshan Nilayams to institutionalise post literacy and continuing education for the neo-literates emerging out of the basic literacy programme. Libraries and reading rooms with appropriate literature forms an important feature of the programme.

### Statue of Buddha

(a) whether Government are aware that the world's biggest monolithic statue of Buddha, is lying in Hussain Sagar Lake for the last two years; and

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) The statue of Buddha proposed to be installed in the Hussain Sagar Lake by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh is still lying under water. The State Government are making efforts to retrieve it and install it at the proposed site.

(b) whether a fresh survey is proposed to be undertaken to assess the expenditure on I.I.T. and I.I.M. students per annum, the fees and other charges paid by the students, and income from other sources?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) As per the decision of the IIT Council the uniform hike in tuition fee and other charges in U.Ts per annum for new entrants with effect from 1992-93 is as under:—

#### **Request transfers in Kendriya "Vidyalayas**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether transfer of teachers on request is an annual sessional-feature in Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan;

(b) if so, what are the reasons for not inviting applications for such transfers in respect of 1991-92 session;

(c) whether the existing Transfer Guides lines have been/are being amended;

(d) if so, what are the details of the modifications; and

(e) by when the applications for request transfers for 1992-93 are likely to be invited?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) to (e) The transfer of teachers is normally an annual feature but the applications for request transfers will be invited after the finalisation of the transfer guidelines effective from 1992-93.

#### **Choice posting of Kendriya Vidyalaya teachers**

4156. SHRI MOHD. KHALEELUR RAHMAN: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Kendriya Vidyalaya teachers<sup>1</sup> are posted to difficult stations and North Eastern Region with the assurance that they would be given a choice posting after two or three years;

(b) if so, what are the details of the teachers who had sought transfers to places of their choice in February—May, 1990 but have not been given the assured transfers; and

(c) what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) to (c) Normally Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan's teachers of all categories posted to difficult stations and Post Graduate Teachers and above posted to North Eastern Region are given postings of their choice after the completion of a tenure of three years subject to availability of vacancies.

#### **Nomination of KVS and its Board of Governors**

(a) the details of the members of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan and its Board of Governors as on date, name and designation-wise;

(b) whether some representatives of KVS employees associations have recently been nominated on these bodies by name; and

(c) if so, the reasons and justification therefor?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) The details of the members of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan and its Board of Governors are at Annexure. [See Appendix CLXJI, Annexure No. 86.]

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) The Government makes nominations to the Sangathan and to its Board of Governors, of persons who can contribute to the objectives of the Sangathan. The recent nominations enable the Sangathan
