Indira Gandhi National Centre for Arts

- (a) "what are the activities of the Indira Gandhi National Centre for Arts;
- (b) what were the annual allocations for the IGNCA during the last three years; and
- (c) what is the monitoring apparatus for IGNCA?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN"RE SOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH); (a) The Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts encompasses all the arts in their dimension of the past and present dialogue between India and

cognate cultures and other' discipline* of science and philosophy and the continual interplay of the rural and the urban, the oral and the textual. The activities Of the Centre are carried out through the following four Academic Divisions: (1) Kala Nidhi; (2) Kala Kosa; (3) Janapada Sam-pada; and (4) Kala Darsna. The specific activities of each one of these Divisions are as follows:—

- (1) Kala Nidhi:Establishment of a Reference Library of multi-media collec tions for the purpose of researcr in humanities and the arts; a computerised National Information System and Data
- Bank on arts, humanities and cultural heritage; and cultural archieves on collections of eminent scholars, artists. musicians, dancers, sculptors, etc;
 - (2) Kala Kosa: Programme of re search on fundamental terminology re-

lating to the arts in its interface of science, technology, metaprysics, and philosophy, research, editing, translation and publication of fundamental texts related to the Indian arts; reprinting of critical writings on Indian arts; and compilation of a multi-volume eucyclopaedia of arts;

- (3) Janapada Sampada: Collection of material and documentation of folk and tribal arts and crafts; multidisciplinary lifestyle studies of tribal communities; establishment of two permanent gallaries devoted to aboriginal and prehistoric rock art called Adi-Drsya, and to sound music and musical instruments called Adi-Srvya; multi-disciplinary research on particular regions in the country which have become cultural complexes, and implementation of programmes for children based on the rich heritage of tribal and folk cultures; and
- (4) Kala Darsana: Organising multidisciplinary programmes on unified themes.

The four Academic Divisions are given administrative, managerial, and organisational support by a modal division! called Sutradhara.
