#### Funds released for rural water supply and Gramodaya Yojana in Assam

2560. SHRIMATI BASANTI SARMA: Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the details of funds allocated and released for the State of Assam under Rural Water Supply Programme and Gramodaya Yojana during the last two years and in current year till date; and

(b) how much amount has been utilised in the state so far District-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ANNASAHEB M.K. PATIL): (a) and (b) Drinking water supply being a state subject, schemes for providing drinking water facilities to rural habitations are implemented by the States from their own resources. The Government of India supplements the efforts of the States by

providing financial assistance under the Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP) and Drinking Water Supply component of the Prime Minister's Gramodaya Yojana (PMGY). The details of funds allocated, released and utilised in respect of the State of Assam under ARWSP and PMGY during the last two years and current year, as per the information received till 16.11.2001 are as under:
