

to time to make amendments in certain labour legislations and steps initiated accordingly. A Group of Ministers on Labour Reforms has been constituted.

The Government has also set up the Second National Commission on Labour with a view to suggest rationalization of existing laws relating to labour in the organised sector and to suggest an umbrella legislation for ensuring a minimum level of protection to the workers in the unorganized sector. The Commission would, *inter-alia*, take into account the emerging economic environment involving rapid technological changes, globalisation of economy, liberalization of trade and industry, emphasis on international competitiveness and also the need for bringing the existing laws in tune with the future labour market needs and demands. The report of the Commission is expected by 15-02-2002.
