Dumping of garbage in front of School in Laxmi Nagar, Delhi

2340. SHRI CHATURANAN MISHRA: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is regular dumping of garbage in front of M.C. Primary Girls School. Guru Ramdas Nagar, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi;
- (b) whether during the recess children play near this dumping ground where even eatables are sold;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that a number of small shops have been set up adjoining the walls of this school; and
- (d) if so, the steps being taken to keep the surroundings of the school clean and healthy?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) According to the information furnished by M.C.D.. dumping of garbage is done in an open space outside the school boundary. Education Department of

- M.C.D. has already taken up the matter with the authorities concerned. The Education Department of M.C.D. has also informed us that the children are not allowed to go outside the school compound during the school hours and recess.
- (c) & (d) It has been ascertained from the Education Department of M.C.D. that there were some shops selling vegetables, tea, pan etc. outside the school premises and adjacent to the school building. These shops were removed. However, some shops have come up again and the matter has been brought to the notice of the authorities concerned.

Adult Education Programme

- (b) the names of the agencies through whom the said amount was spent:

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- (c) the number of agencies and voluntary organisations engaged in spreading of the Adult Education and the amount provided to them yearwise, during the said period;
- (d) whether the target fixed for the last 3 years in this regard have been achieved; and
- (e) if so, the number of persons made literate annually during the said period?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) Statement showing Central assistance provided to State Governments/Union Territories and other agencies in different States/UTs engaged in Adult Education during 1988-89, 1989-90 and 199-91 is attached. (See below)

(b) (c) The Central assistance is provided to the State Governments/ UT Administrations and other agencies engaged in literacy/Adult Education under the following schemes:—

- (i) Under the Scheme of Rural Functional Literacy Projects, finaancial assistance is provided to State Governments/Ut Administrations for running projects of literacy/Adult Education.
- (ii) Under the Scheme of Jana Shikshan Nilayams, financial assistance is provided to State Governments/UT Administration for running Jana Shikshan Nilayams for providing post literacy and follow-up activities.
- (iii) Under the Central Scheme of Assistance to Voluntary Agencies in the field of Adult Education, voluntary gencies are provided assistance for running literacy/adult education programme, Jana Shikshana Nilayams, development of teaching-learning material, organisation of seminars, etc. During previous three years 646 voluntary agencies were assisted. Number of voluntary agencies and amount released to them during the period of three years is as follows:—

- (iv) Under the Scheme of mass Programme of Functional Literacy financial assistance is provided to State Resource Centres for production of literacy kits to supply to all concerned agencies who want to implement the programme through student and non-student volunteers.
- (v) Under the Scheme of strengthening Administrative structure in States/UTs, Central Assistance is provided for maintenance of structure at State and District level for the management of Adult Education Programme in the States/UTs.

(d) and (e) Objective of National Literacy Mission was to impart functional literacy to 30.00 million illiterate persons in 15-35 age-group by 1990 and additional 50 million by 1995. Number of persons enrolled during the last 3 years is as followe:—

Scholarship to Students of Hilly Areas for higher education

2342. SHRI RATNA BAHADUR RAI: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any provision for grant of scholarship to students of hilly areas for higher education; and
 - (b) if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN' RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) The Ministry of Human Resource Development has no separate provision for grant of scholarships to students of hilly areas but they are considered alongwith others under existing schemes.

Non-Payment of Salary to Teachers under D. M. C.

2343. SHRI N. E. BALARAM: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware that in some schools under Delhi Municipal Corporation, teachers were not paid their pay for October even upto 23rd November, 1991;
- (b) whether it is a fact that bonus and arrears of D.A. have also not been paid till date; and

(c) if so, the reasons therefor and the steps being taken to ensure that payment is made to them every month?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir.

(c) According to the information furnished by MCD, in some schools teachers could not be paid their salaries of October, 1991 upto 23-11-91 due to shortage of funds in some Zonal offices and non-compliance of certain formalities by some teachers.

Regular meetings are held with the Finance Department of M.C.D. to provide adequate funds at Zonal levels for making payment of salary and other dues to the teachers by 7th of every month. Zonal Officers have also been instructed to ensure timely payment to teachers.

Transfers of Teachers of Port Blair

(a) whether it is a fact that a number of Teachers of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Port Blair are awaiting transfer to mainland, having completed their tenure in the Islands 'since long;
