THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STEEL (SHRI SONTOSH MOHAN DEV): (a) and (b) Opening of a stockyard is proposed by SAIL at Jhalukbari, near Guwahati on Broad Gauge. A plot of land measuring approximately 20 acres has been identified for the larger stockyard and SAIL has requested the Government of Assam to take necessary steps for the acquisition of the said plot of land.

Steel Plant The Visakhapatnam (VSP) is also establishing a consignment agency at Guwahati in Assam. The preliminary process has just been started.

India Educational Survey (Reference dated 30-9-1986), the number of primary and upper primary schools in Union Territories the States and covered under various incentives schemes like provision of free textbooks, free uniforms and mid-day students of indigent meals, to the families or those belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and the number of students receiving such benefits, are given below:

In respect of students of 261 residential Navodaya Vidyalayas run by Government for the Central talented children predominantly from the rural areas all expenses including board and lodging, uniforms, textbooks, stationery and railbus from and to their home stations are free. As per the latest data available, 77.36 per cent of the students Navodaya Vidyalayas are from rural areas, 20.18 per cent of the students of Navodava Vidvalavas belong Scheduled Castes and 11.21 per cent to the Scheduled Tribes.

The income limit specified in determining the eligibility of a student for availing of these benefits and the basis thereof vary from State to State. The students of Navodaya Vidyalayas receive the benefits irrespective of their parental income.

Foreign Seed Companies in Indian Market
