Implementation of India-Soviet Accord

- 2558. SHRI G.Y. KRISHNAN: will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) what are the details of schemes included in the protocol signed between India and USSR during Mr. Gorbachev's visit to India two years back; and
- (b) how far they have been implemented?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI): (a) and (b) President M.S. Gorbachev visited India last in November 1988. Details of implementation of agreements signed during this visit are being obtained from the concerned Ministries/Departments.

LTTE Ships involvement in Arms Smuggling

- 2559. SHRI GHUFRAN AZAM: Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Governments attention has been drawn to the newsitem captioned "LTTE ships involved in arms smuggling" as reported in the Hindustan Times dated 16th November, 1991;

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI MADHAVSINH SOLANKI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c) Government have received reports of LTTE owned ships involved in smuggling of arms and ammunition etc. In order to prevent unlawful activity smugglers/militants off the Tamil Nadu coast, Government have taken steps to intensify naval patrolling within the International Boundary Line.

India's stand on nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty
