**Postal Staff College at Hyderabad**

**Assistance to Indian students in Soviet Union**

\*436. SHRI MENTAY PADAMANA-BHAM: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that a large number of Indian students are presently studying in the Soviet Union:

(b) whether Government have taken any steps to examine the difficulties of those students due to the recent political and economic changes there;

(c) whether any liaison has been maintained with our Embassy in the USSR in the matter; and

(d) what steps are being taken to assist our students in the USSR?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) There are 3409 students studying in the Soviet Union of which 19 students have been sponsored by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Education) and 205 by the Medical Council of India.

(b) to (d) Indian students in the USSR are not facing any special problem which are not experienced by other foreigners or even Soviet citizens arising out of recent developments. Our Embassy in Moscow is in touch with the students and Soviet authorities and has taken up the question of enhancement of stipend for students with the concerned Soviet authorities.
