THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) According to the information furnished by the Delhi Administration, Minority Welfare Day was observed in various schools in the Union Territory of Delhi on 20th November 1991 as part of Quami Ekta Week, during which meetings, symposia, seminars and competitions were organised.

(c) to (e) It is too early to take a decision in this regard. However, it is always the endeavour of the Govt. to promote welfare of the minorities.
