HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DEPARTMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT) (KUMARI MAMATA BANERJEE): (a) and (b) The Government is considering a few new initiatives in this direction. These include integrated programmes for the development of women; establishment of a National Credit Fund for Women; the National Commission for Women and the setting up of the office of the Commissioner for Women's Rights which will benefit all categories of women including rural women. The Government has already introduced a new initiative in the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme consisting of a package of services for the adolescent girls.
