

Irrigation Projects Affected by Flood in Andhra Pradesh

3042. SHRI R. SARATH KUMAR: Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of irrigation projects affected by recent floods in several districts in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the extent of damage caused to the projects; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to renovate the said projects?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (MS. BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY): (a) as per information furnished by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, 10 nos. of major, 20 nos. of medium and 1251 nos. of minor irrigation projects have been affected by recent floods in the State.

- (b) 2115 number of breaches[^]cours had occurred during the floods.
- (c) The State Government of Andhra Pradesh has taken up the temporary restoration works of the damaged irrigation systems and released an amount of Rs. 4.00 crore. An amount of Rs. 9.85 crore has also been recommended for release by the Central Government for restoration of irrigation works.
