DR. RATNAKAR PANDEY :*

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: I said it very clearly that Special Mentions which the Chairman has permitted... (Interruptions) If you want to say anything, let the Members who have taken pains to give a Special Mention, have the privilege to raise it. You cannot just get up and raise any issue you like. Otherwise what is the use of having Special Mentions? Please understand the difficulty... (Interruptions)

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Madam, let me raise a very serious matter. The assassins of Rajiv Gandhi are in Delhi. The Government is having a surveillance at the air-

ports, but there are other routes also which are ... (Interruptions) Madam, it is a very serious matter. This report has come. (Interruptions)

SHRI A. G. KULKARNI: Madam...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Your matter has come as a Special Mention. I will permit you at that time. Is it about the Mandal Commission? (Interruptions) I will allow it. (Interruptions) So you are recored. Now, don't speak without my permission.

Let me organize the House, please. Now, it is over.

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: Madam, the assassins of Rajiv Gandhi are in Delhi. (Interruptions) I want the Home Minister to ...

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: The Home Minister is not here.

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: I want the Home Minister to seal the border so that these people can be arrested. There are other escape routes. They have to be vigilant.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Please take your seat.

SHRI V. NARAYANASAMY: They have got vital clues. They are the prime suspects.

THE DEPUTY CHAIRMAN: Don't repeat it again and again. I have understood you. Please take your seat.
