622. **SHRI SYED SIBTEY RAZI:**
Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether C.G.H.S. dispensary at Paharganj has a strength of one C.M.O. and 5 S. M.Os.;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof;

(c) whether no C.M.O. has been posted in the dispensary for the last 9 months;

(d) whether all the doctors and members of staff of the dispensary are available during the working hours of the dispensary;

(e) whether it is a fact that there are only two pharmacist counters in the dispensary and only two doctors are available in the dispensary for examination and treatment of patients for the last six months; and

(f) if so, what steps are being taken to improve the functioning of the dispensary?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE AND DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI DASA CHOWDHARY):

(a) and (b) The staff strength of doctors in CGHS dispensary Paharganj is as under:—

1 C.M.O. — 1 (One)

2 M.O. — 4 (Four)

(c) No Sir, However, from 17/10/90 to 06.02.91 the dispensary was without a C.M.O. due to administrative reasons. A C.M.O. has since been posted in the dispensary from 7th February, 1991.

(d) Yes, Sir.

(e) and (f) Two pharmacists counters are functioning 3 to 4 Medical Officers including Chief Medical

Officers are on duty during working hours. The dispensary is functioning normally.
