Production of Environmental-friendly Detergents

@@532. SHRI SHAMIM HASHMI: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian Additives Limited are to produce detergents as reported in the Economic Times dated 29.11.1990; and if so, the details thereof; and

(b) whether it would be ensured that the new products have environmental adaptability unlike some of the detergent products now in the market?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI SATYA PRAKASH MALAVIYA): (a) and (b) Indian Additives Ltd. propose to manufacture additive packages used for the production of lubricating oils. They will also manufacture some intermediate components which will include sulfonate and phenate detergents. These are different than the detergents used in the soap industry.

The products proposed to be manufactured by IAL will meet all environmental requirements.

3. Madras unit—Surgical Instruments & Formulation unit.
4. Muzaffarpur unit—Drugs Intermediates and Vitamins.
5. Gurgaon unit—Formulation unit.

IDPL has also set up the following joint sector formulation units in collaboration with the State Industrial Development Corporations:

- (1) Uttar Pradesh Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Lucknow (UPDPL).
- (2) Orissa Drugs & Chemicals Ltd., Bhubaneswar (ODCL).
- (3) Rajasthan Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Ltd., Jaipur (RDPL).
