

Duty Draw Backs to Trade and Industry

2981. SHRI SANJAY NIRUPAM: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are paying duty drawbacks to the trade and industry against exports;

(b) if so, the details of the companies which have availed of duty drawbacks over the last three years; and

(c) what is the total amount Government have paid under various categories as duty drawbacks?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI GINGEE N. RAMACHANDRAN): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The Government is paying duty drawbacks to the Trade and Industry for the exports made by them. The Government disburses drawback by way of All Industry Rates and Brand Rates. During the last three years, the total amount of drawback disbursed to the Trade and Industry is given below:—
