2870. SHRI P. PRABHAKAR REDDY: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is fact that the Railways are planning to junk the brake vans on passenger trains;

(b) if so, the details of the proposed move and the reasons therefor; and

(c) what alternatives are being a contemplated to cater to the end-to-end movement of parcels, including newspapers and perishables, and ensure an assured delivery thereof on time?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI O. RAJAGOPAL): (a) No, Sir.

S&T Programmes in Manipur

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (SHRI BACHI SINGH RAWAT): (a) The total amount of funds sanctioned so far for taking up science and technology programmes in Manipur for 2001-2002 is Rs. 234.79 lakh. In addition, Rs. 17 crores have been allocated to Central Agricultural University, Imphal for the agricultural research and education for 2001-2002.

(b) The Government is implementing a number of programmes in various fields such as vermincomposting, sericulture,

aquaculture, animal husbandry, poultry farming, Krishi Vigyan Kendras etc. for development of science & technology in rural areas.

(c) In other North-Eastern States, programmes under science communication, bio-technology, non-conventional energy, seismicity, S&T entrepreneurship, basic research agricultural research, research facilities, Natural Resource Data Management System and core support for strengthening State S&T Councils etc. have been supported to develop Science & Technology.
