

### Self-sufficiency in production of fertilizers

57. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether the fertilizer industry is likely to be hard pressed during the Gulf War;

(b) if so, to what extent the prices of naphtha and finished fertilizers have gone up;

(c) whether according to the experts the self-sufficiency in fertilizers is not likely to be achieved;

(d) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(e) what are the steps being taken by Government to improve the fertilizer production?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COOPERATION IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI JYANTILAL VIRCHAND-BHAI SHAH): (a) While the nitrogenous fertilizer industry has not been affected, the phosphatic fertilizer units, which depend on imported intermediates, have been partially affected due to the Gulf War.

(b) The price of Naphtha has gone up on account of 25 per cent Gulf Surcharge. However, the selling price of indigenous fertilizers has not been increased.

(c) and (d) While the self sufficiency in nitrogenous fertilizers will be nearly achieved, in case of phosphatic

tic fertilizers, domestic raw material constraints do not permit self sufficiency.

Supply of additional edible oil to M.P.
