country was 36,23 per cent. A Statement showing, State-wise, the literacy according to 1981 census is attached.

(b) Universalisation of elementary education and universal retention in schools of children upto 14 years of programme of non-formal education in the ten educationally States and the National backward Literacy Mission which aims at imfunctional literacy to 80 parting million adult illiterates in the 15-35 age-group by 1995 form an integral part of a larger programme for eradication of illiteracy in the country.

The emphasis under National Literacy Mission is on adopting an area approach in an attempt to eradicate illiteracy in that area in a time bound Accordingly, total literacy manner. campaigns have been/are being launched in the entire States of Kerala and Goa, Union Territory of Pondicherry, 100 talukas in Gujarat and in districts in the States of 31 other Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Orissa, Pradesh and West Bengal.
