Opening of residential polytechnic for women at Jodhpur

179. SHRI B. L. PANWAR: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the project submitted by Rajasthan Government for opening a residential polytechnic for Women at Jodhpur under direct Central assistance has been finalised and approved; and

(b) if not, by when it is likely to be finalised?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAJMANGAL PANDE): (a) and (b) In view of the project on Technician Education launched with World Bank assistance it has been decided not to take up for implementation the proposed scheme for setting up of residential polytechnics for women under the Central Sector. Rajasthan is covered in the first phase of the project which is under implementation.
